SUBJECT: **Public Safety Program (7:15 am to 5:30 pm)**

We are looking forward to seeing everyone at our Tampa Connection's Public Safety Day! This program offers a unique opportunity to visit The Tampa Police Academy and The Tampa International Airport. You will have the opportunity to tour both facilities and learn about their mission to promote public safety in our community.

This is a full day of activities (indoors and outdoors). Please plan on packing light, dress accordingly (business casual attire/Tampa Connection shirt and slacks), and wear comfortable shoes! Sunblock is recommended.

We are meeting up at TIA, where you will park for the day and board the buses that will transport us to The Police Training Academy. (You must follow our parking directions included in this memorandum).

The program will kick off at the Police Training Academy, where Senior Corporal Jared Douds will welcome the class with an overview of the Academy while we indulge in Krispy Kreme doughnuts and coffee. We will then split into 2 groups for a series of exercises including Tactical Driving, Intervention Techniques and Pursuits, a tour of the Range Facility, and a final live demonstration by the SWAT team. We will then head over to Tampa International Airport for a presentation by FBI Agent Christopher Johnston, and a behind the scenes tour of TIA's baggage handling system, and exciting tours and demos at TIA's K-9 and Training Facility.

The Tampa Police Academy, TIA employees and Tampa Connection planning committee have put a lot of time and effort into making this a great program. Please be prepared to participate. It shows interest and appreciation when you ask questions and show engagement.

Cell phone usage during the program is deeply frowned upon and we ask that you be respectful during the tours. We have allotted breaks within the program to check emails and make calls.

Upon completion of the program, we will have a Tampa Connection sponsored Happy Hour at the Marriott Rooftop Lounge.

IMPORTANT NOTES FOR THE DAY: Because we will be going to the Police Academy and Tampa International Airport, due to security considerations you should travel as lightly as possible; avoid backpacks and large purses. DO NOT carry anything with you that would not be allowed on an airplane. During the airport tours, bags will be subject to search.

7:15 - 7:30 a.m. Park personal cars in the Tampa Airport **Short Term Parking Garage**. Take any elevator to the **Third Level** and proceed to the **Information Center** (blue side, behind Brookstone; red side, behind Starbucks). Guest Services Representatives will escort you to the buses on lower level.

IMPORTANT PARKING NOTES:

- In order to have your parking pass validated later in the day, take a ticket when entering the garage - DO NOT use the Sunpass lane. Keep your ticket with you to be validated when you return to the airport for lunch.
- After parking your car, you can take a location reminder card near the elevator to remind you which level and section of the garage you are in.

IMPORTANT NOTE: You must take everything with you from the Boardroom as it will be used for other meetings after we leave for our tours and you will not be returning to the room.

- 12:45 - 1:30 Groups 1 & 2 - Baggage Handling Systems tours
Groups 3 & 4 - Airport Operations Center/Incident Command Center tours
- 1:30 Meet and switch groups at the aquarium
- 1:35 - 2:15 Groups 3 & 4 - Baggage Handling Systems tours
Groups 1 & 2 - Airport Operations Center/Incident Command Center tours
- 2:15 - 2:30 Bathroom Break and Board Buses to Airport Police Training Facility with Police escorts across airfield
- 2:30 - 5:00 K-9 and Training Facility Tours and Demos: Firearms Training System (FATS), K-9s, Active Shooter - Sergeant Eric (EJ) Diaz will split you into groups by colored stickers on badges for portions of the tour
- 5:00 Buses depart from Police Training Facility back to Main Terminal
Guest Services Representatives will escort you from buses to Marriott
- 5:00 - 7:00 p.m. Happy Hour at Marriott Rooftop Lounge - press elevator button that says CK/View

When you are ready to leave, take the Marriott elevators back to Lobby level, walk back through the Airport Gallery to the Main Terminal and take the same elevator you used in the morning to get back to your car.

IMPORTANT PARKING NOTE: In order to use your free parking validation, you must exit the garage using one of the lanes marked **CASHIER**.
